Candy Canes on Main to kick off with parade

lighted parade starts at 6:30 p.m. on Friday evening. December 1, 2023.

This year the parade line up will start at 5:30 p.m. and

The Candy Canes on Main will have two entry points. One is on East Edgar Avenue beside the Circle K and the other will be on East Georgia Avenue, close to Preferred Bank. These streets will be blocked

off starting at 5:30 to allow participants to get into

Due to the darkness, there

are no assigned spots. Parade officials will meet parade entries at the entry points and will direct participants to a parade position.

The parade will travel south

onto Northeast 4th Street towards Roosevelt School and then turn onto East Main Street. It will then cross over Central Avenue and continue traveling across West Main Street, ending at Southwest 3rd Street.

For safety reasons, starting at 4 p.m., parking along East Main and West Main in the downtown area will be blocked off for

the parade. No candy will be tossed during the pa-

rade.

The Casey Warrior High School Baseball Team will be selling glow-getters along the parade route from 5:30 to 6:30 p.m.

There will be a live feed of the entire parade. This can be viewed on the Candy Canes on Main Facebook page.

Immediately following the parade, Santa can be found on the balcony of Terra Cottage, where he will read "Twas the Night Before Christmas" and then toss treats to the children below.

The lighted holiday parade has become a family tradition for many in the community. It's not to late to be in the parade. There are a few requirements to be in the parade. Lights and lots of them! Each entry must be decorated with lights. Also, large equipment entries will

> need someone to walk along each side of the entry to ensure safety.

fore the parade, but it helps to plan ahead to ensure space for the lineup.
