General Notice

The City of Marshall (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

Second Street Water Main Replacement

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received by the City Clerk at Marshall City Hall located at 201 S. Michigan Avenue, Marshall, IL 62441, until day, April 8, 2025, at 10am local time. At that time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

The Project Base Bid includes the replacement of approximately 3,300 LF of water main on Second Street from Vine Street to Archer Avenue and from the intersection of Second Street and Poplar Street, one block to the east on Poplar Street. Alternate Bid 1 includes the installation of approximately 1,320 LF of water main on Plum Street from Fourth Street to First Street. Alternate Bid 2 the installation of approximately 285 LF of water main for the Maple Street Apartment Complex. This work will generally consist of the furnishing and installation of water system piping, fittings, valves, hydrants, services, connections, disconnections, and appurtenances for potable water. Installation will consist of 8" PVC SDR-21 Water Main along design route. This work also includes surface restoration with various pavements, curbing, and sidewalk. The work shall include all labor, supervision, materials, supplies, transportation, equipment, and services necessary and required to perform the project as set forth in the Contract Documents.

Provided the Contractor furnishes proof of proper insurance and bonding in a timely manner, it is anticipated that a Notice of Award of contract will be issued within 30-to-60 days of the date bids are opened and that a Notice to Proceed will be issued within 10 days of the date of the Notice of Award.

This Project shall reach Substantial Completion by May 1, 2026, and Final Completion by June 1, 2026.

Completion dates and requirements are further outlined in the Agreement, document C-520.

Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office Monday through Friday between the hours of 8am and 5pm and may obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including addenda, if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

Electronic document access will only be provided to interested bidding companies and/or equipment companies. Electronic copies are provided at no cost. Printing of such documents will be the responsibility of the plan holder in accordance with the website Terms and Conditions.

Each proposal shall contain the name of every person or firm interested in the same and shall be accompanied by bid bond, certified check, bank draft, or cashier's check payable to the order of City of Marshall, in an amount not less than 5% of the proposal.

The City of Marshall reserves the right to reject any or all bids, waive or not waive any informality in the bids, and to accept any bid which it deems most favorable to the Commission.

It is agreed that this bid may not be withdrawn for a period of 45 days from opening thereof or it will be subject to forfeit the 5% Bid Bond provided with the bid.

Work on this project is subject to the Prevailing Wage

Act (820 ILCS 130). Prevailing Wages, as determined by the Illinois Department of Labor, shall be paid. The contractor shall be responsible for submitting all certified payrolls for the awarded project and for any subcontractor work to the IDOL website pursuant to Public Act 100-1177. Work on this project is subject to the Illinois Substance Abuse Prevention on Public Works Project Act (820 ILCS 265) as enacted by P.A. 95-0635.

Pre-bid Conference

There will not be a pre-bid conference for this Project.
